Background Adobe Walls settlement. Adobe Walls was the name of a trading post in the Texas Panhandle, just north of the Canadian River. In 1845 an adobe fort was built there to house the post, but it was blown up by traders three years later after repeated Indian attacks. In 1864 the ruins were the site of one of the largest battles ever to take place on the Great Plains.

In fact, the maximum height of adobe mission churches in the Southwest was approximately 35 feet. Often buttresses braced exterior walls for added stability.

Preservation Brief 5: Preservation of Historic Adobe Buildings

Adobe walls are often thick, forming a natural insulation from the environmental heat that creates and sustains the material. Today's commercial adobe is sometimes kiln-dried, although purists may call these "clay bricks." Traditional adobe bricks need about a month of drying in the sun before they can be used.

In a typical pueblo building, adobe blocks form the walls of each room as well as a central courtyard; buildings can be up to five stories tall. Usually each floor is set back from the floor below, so that a given building resembles a stepped pyramid.
