Soda lime absorbs carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) through a complex chemical reaction, which also requires

moisture to occur.. So ensure you store your soda lime as per the manufacturer's instructions, and if your soda lime is sitting in the canister for any length of time, change it even if it hasn't reached the 6 to 10 hours of use yet, as dehydrated soda lime cannot absorb CO<sub>2</sub> (1,6).

### **Changing Soda Lime for Vet Nurses - When should it be done?**

A constant rate infusion (CRI) is a medication continuously administered to a patient and is used to maintain consistent plasma levels of that medication. CRIs are commonly administered to patients to achieve appropriate levels of pain management, blood pressure management, sedation, anaesthesia, electrolyte supplementation, insulin, and liquid nutrition via a feeding tube.
